3. Principals Report (Kelly)

Budget Update

- Budget closed
- Big purchases: subpara made permanent, another one shortly (consistency)

- Angie to do more school climate work (support social- emotional learning)
- General school needs: ATS printer, toner, shredder, materials for integrated units, intervention books
- Posting for three day a week SETTS teacher, taking a long time (trying to get Mike Thomas)
- Increased math consultant days with Nikki
- WITTS paid
- Teachers going to training

CEP Update

- 5 goals:
 - 54% ELA proficiency by Feb. using tools already in place
 - Will use state test data to measure
 - At 62% currently using school wide metrics
 - Classroom teachers professional learning around questioning/ discussion, advanced rating 95%
 - At 80%
 - Anticipate meeting goal
 - Advance- observing teachers in cycles of observation, 80% at effective/ highly effective, focus areas 3B
 - Parent involvement 10% attending 60%
 - Not for teacher-led workshops
 - Need to rework for next year, perhaps look at action plan for more involvement & look at what we'll measure
 - School climate- level 2 & 3 OORS infractions decrease by 3%
 - At moment decreased level 4 (higher level), down 30%
 - Increased level 3 by 48%, rethink as well
- Will spend time developing new goals

Learning Environment Survey

- Staff brainstormed plans, looked at what was most effective before and tried to improve, last year 62%, hoping for 80% this year, accountability
- Other ideas for next year?
