- iPlan - public school documents and other schools CEP goals, increased access
- State Test Scores: ELA increased, Math increased, Students with Disabilities increased, ENL remained.
- ENL & SWD are outperforming across district, but are our focus group
- ELA gains dramatically higher than Math gains
- 3rd grade highest performing, 4th grade close behind, 5th grade lowest performing
- Goals around rigorous instruction: State testing
- Learning environment survey - social emotional learning goal - now using OORS
- Parent asked what time teacher led workshops are. Kelly responded that some were offered after school, sometimes after PA meeting, Social emotional was a 6:30 start in October.
